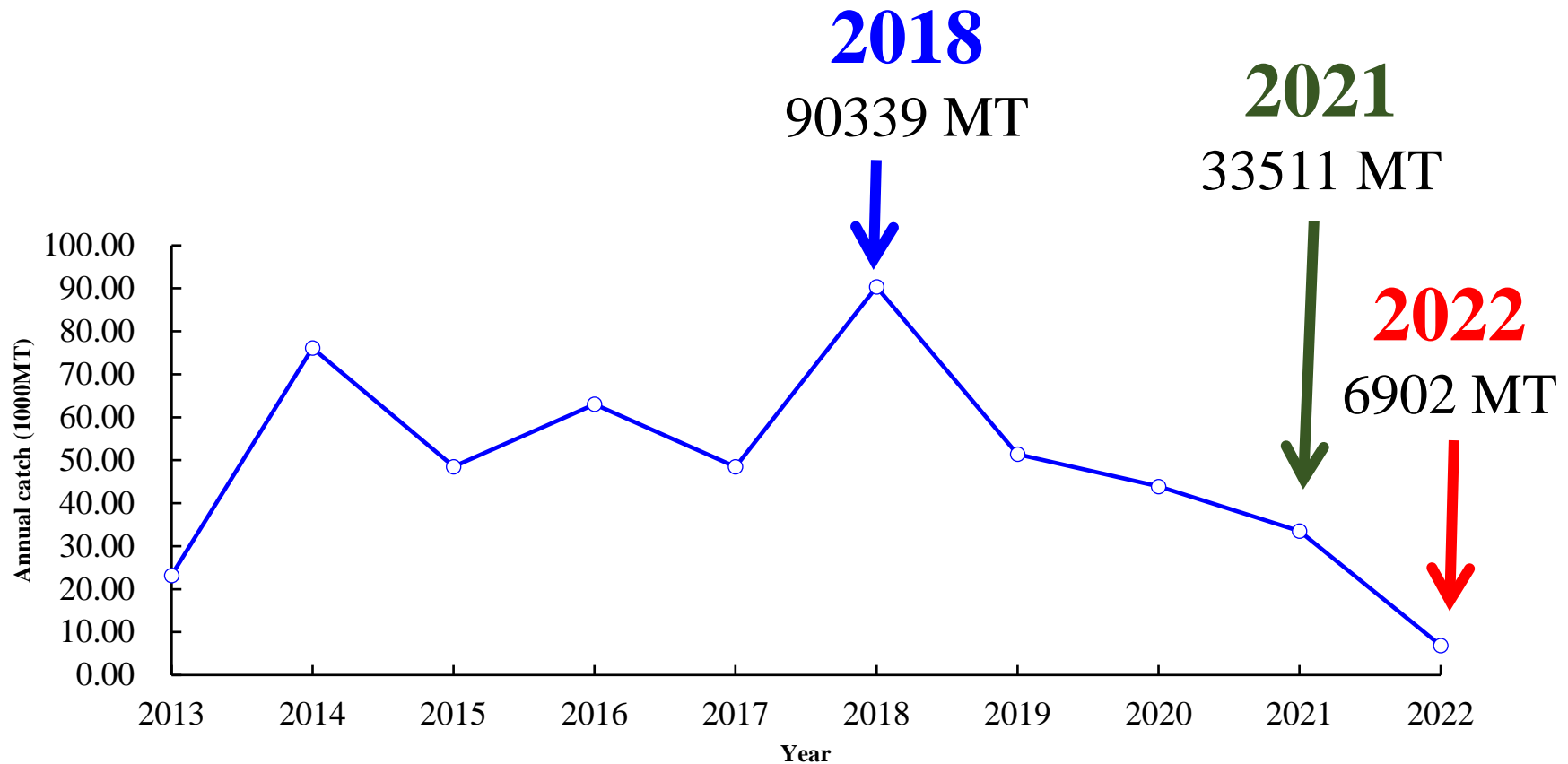

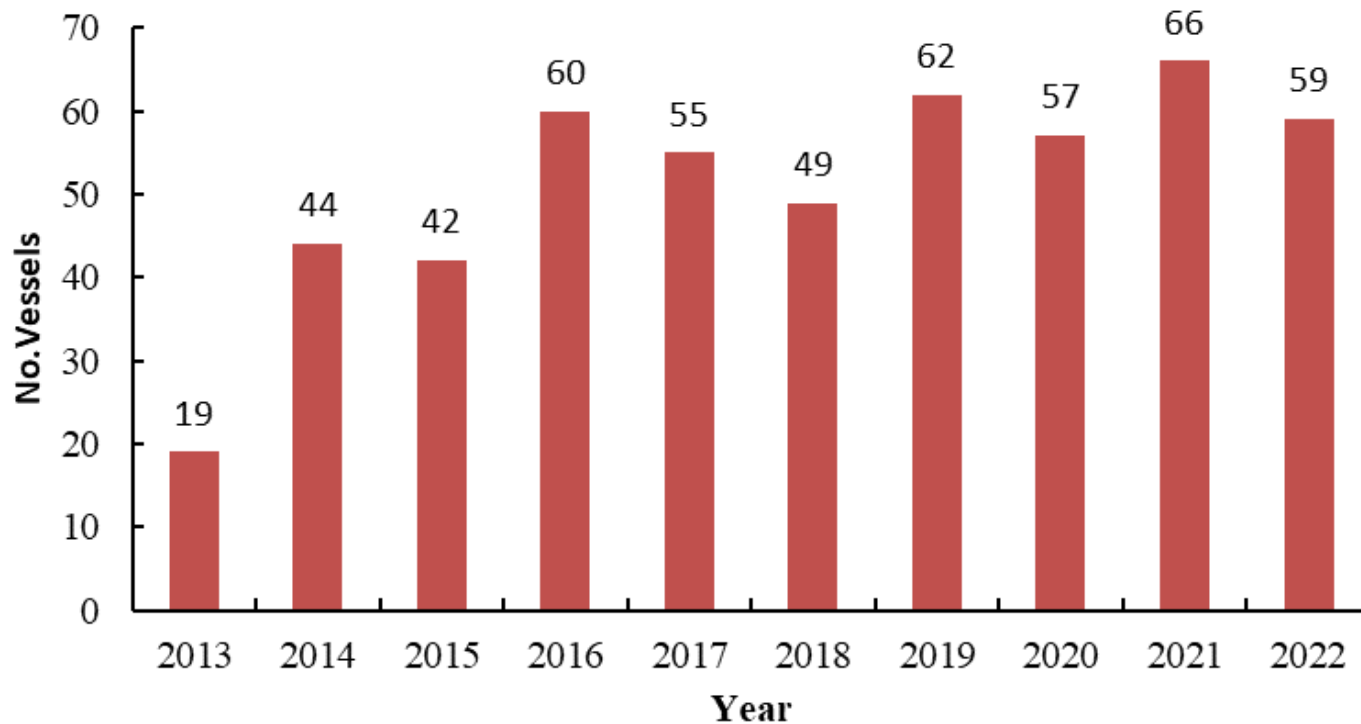

Annual catch



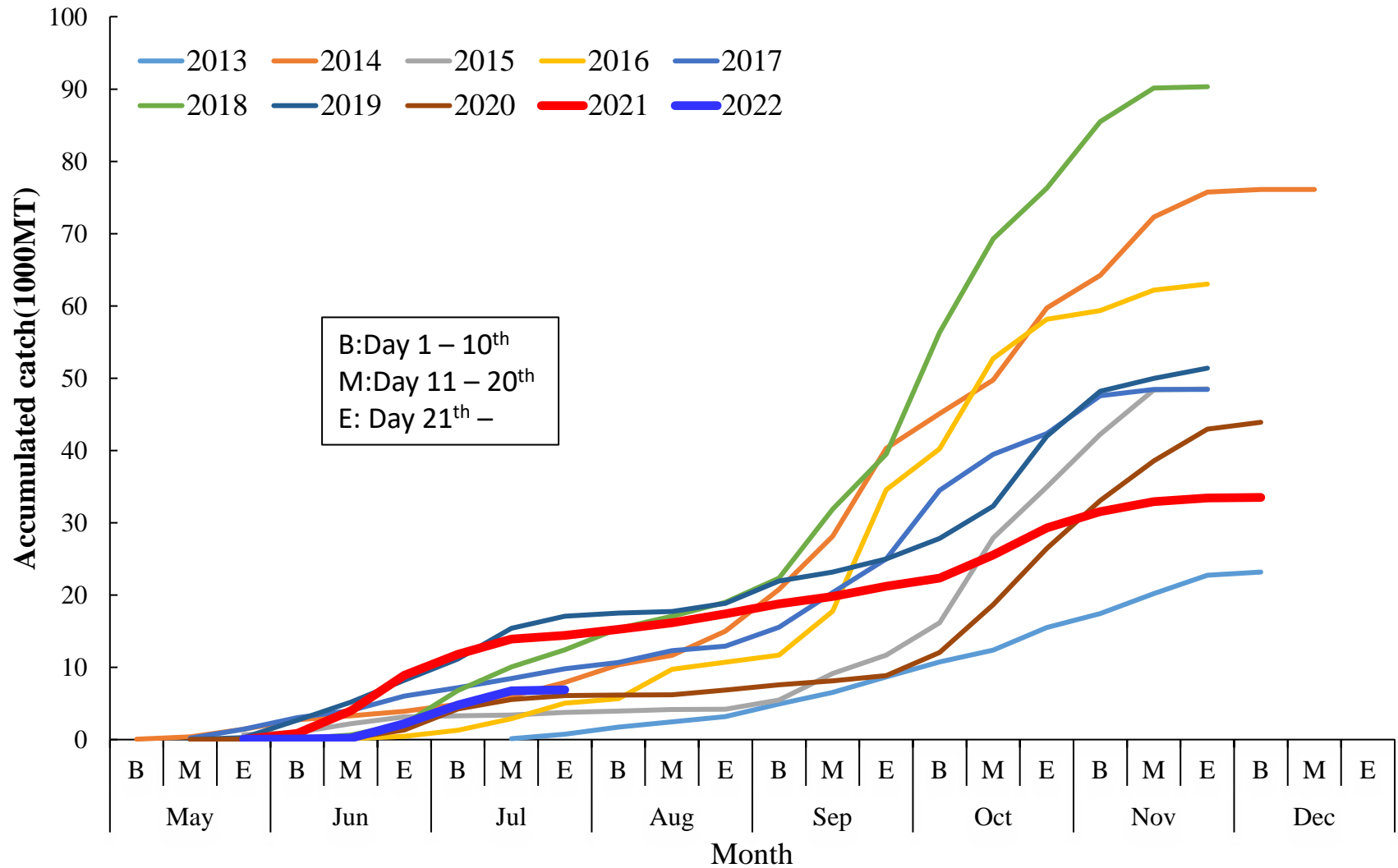
- China's Pacific saury fishery in the Northwest Pacific Ocean began in 2003.

- The annual catch continues to decrease since 2018.
- Total catch in 2021 was 33511 MT
- Total catch in 2022 (till 25 Jul.) was 6902 MT

Number of vessels

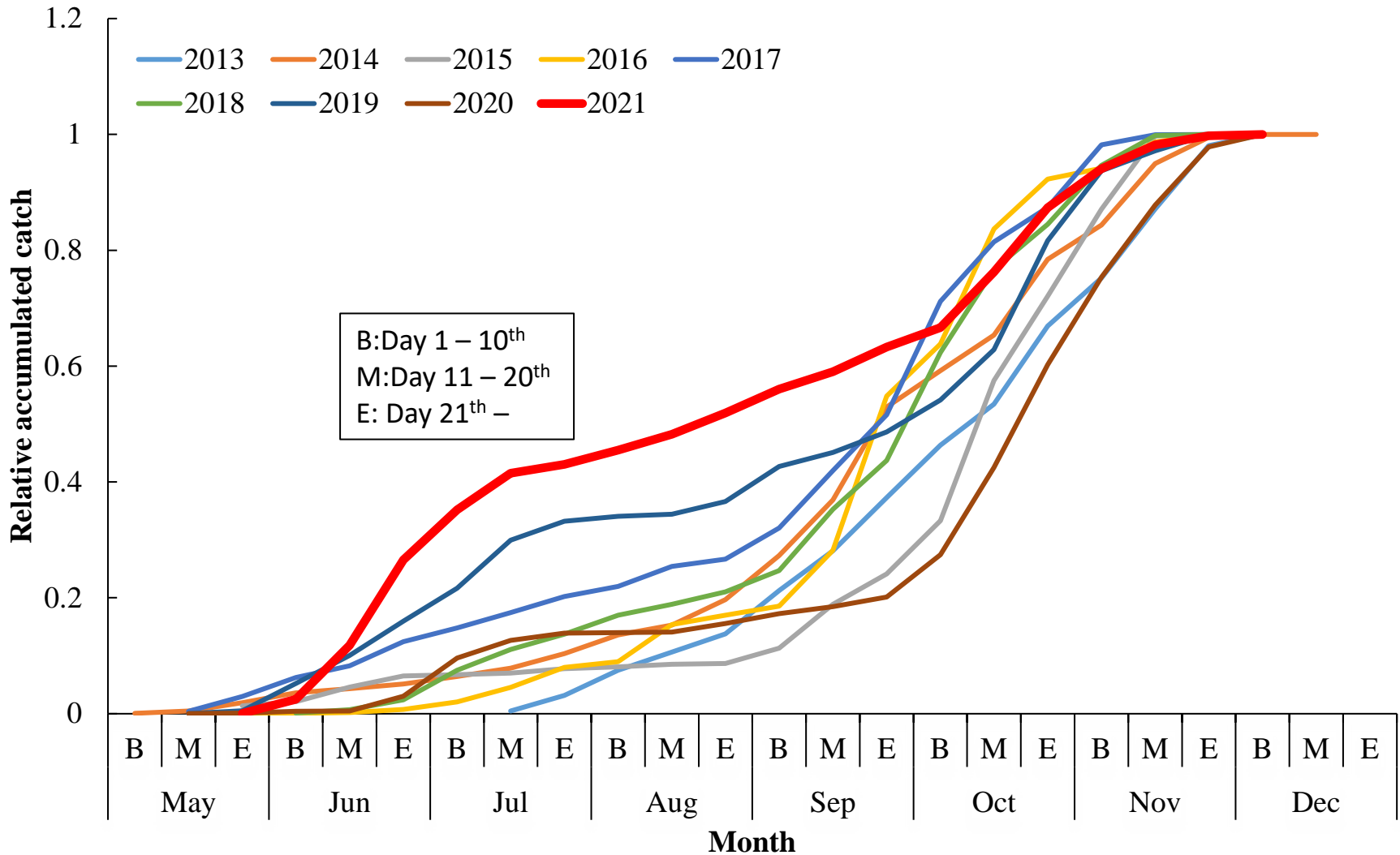


- 59 fishing vessels are operating
- 7 vessels decreased compared to last year

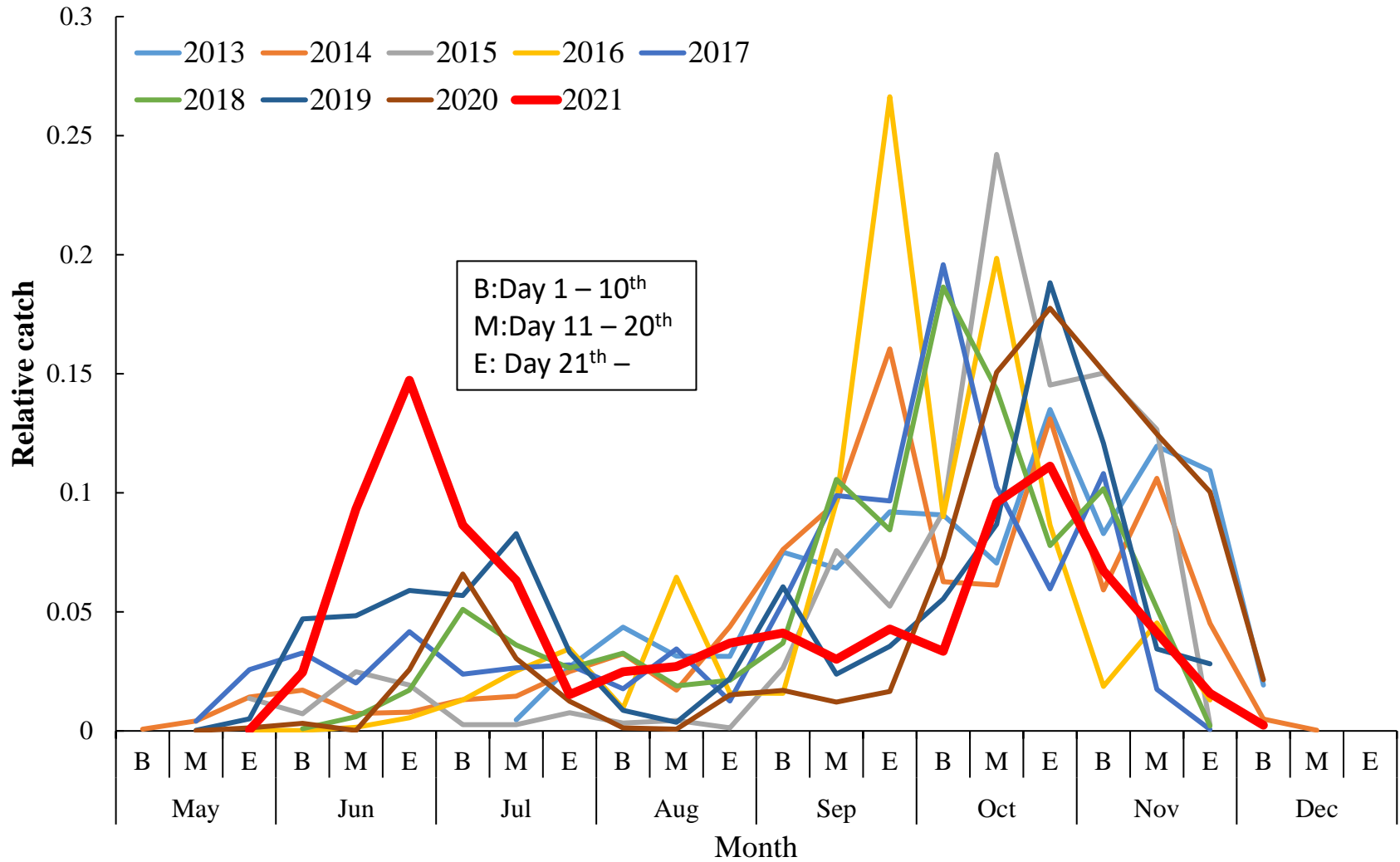
Accumulated catch



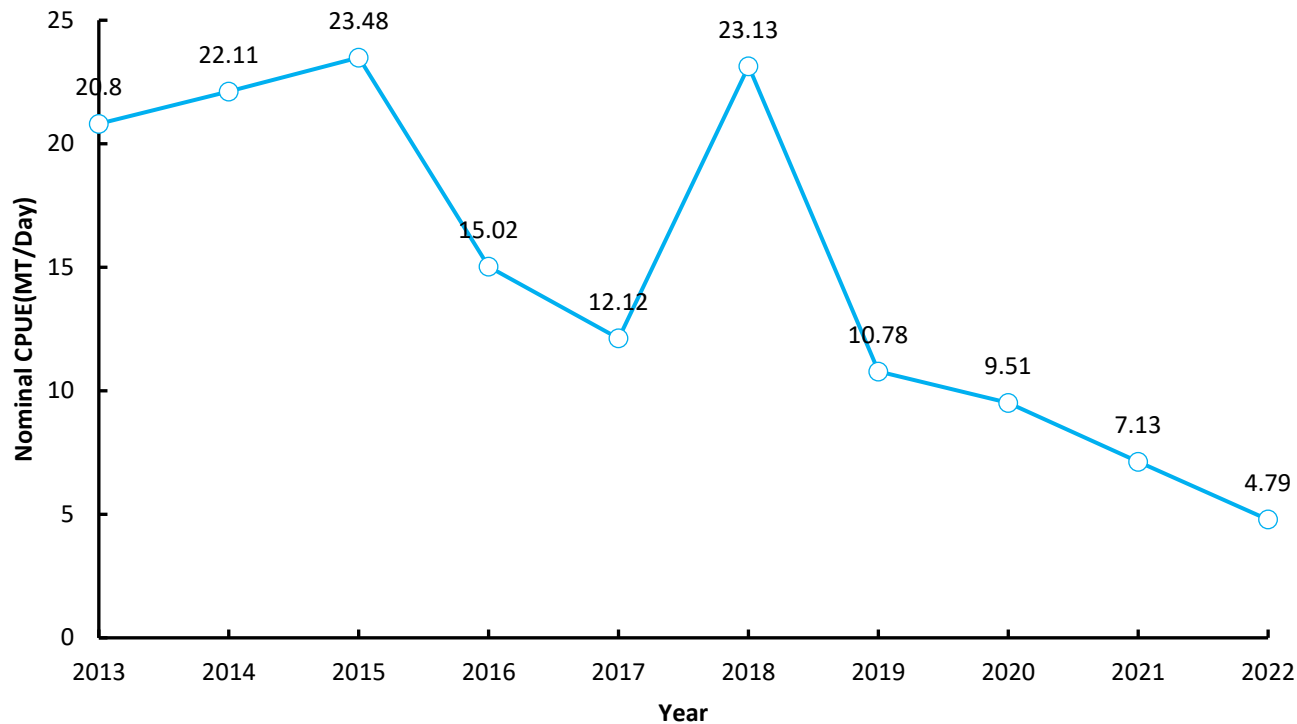
Relative accumulated catch



Relative seasonal catch

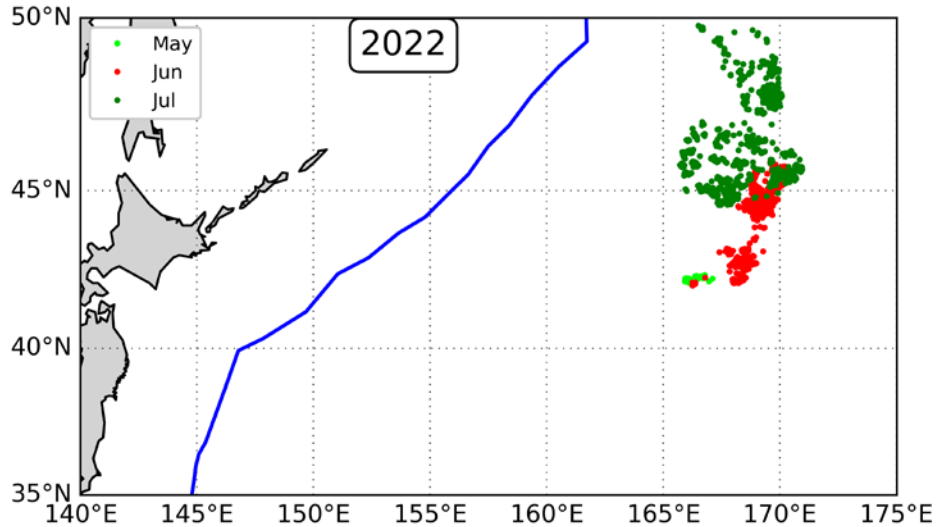

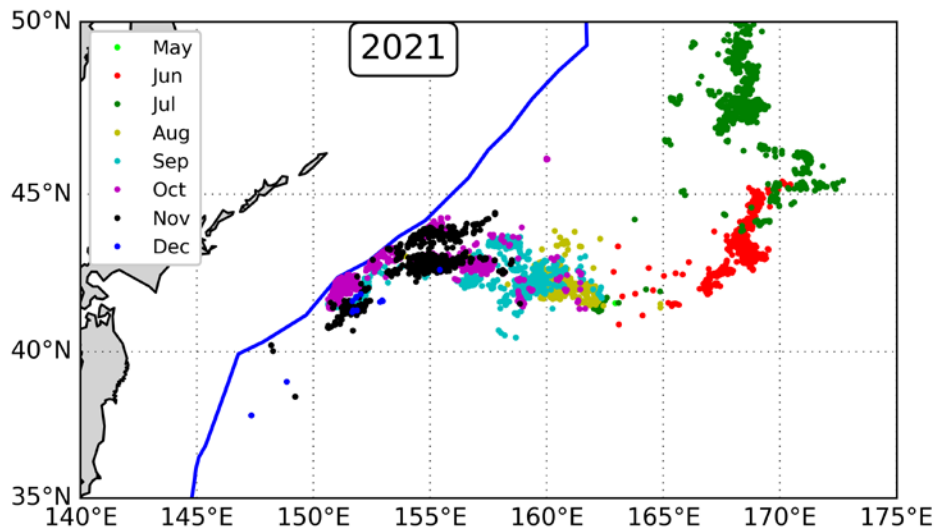


■ Nominal CPUE was 4.79MT/Vessel/Day and lowest since 2013.
