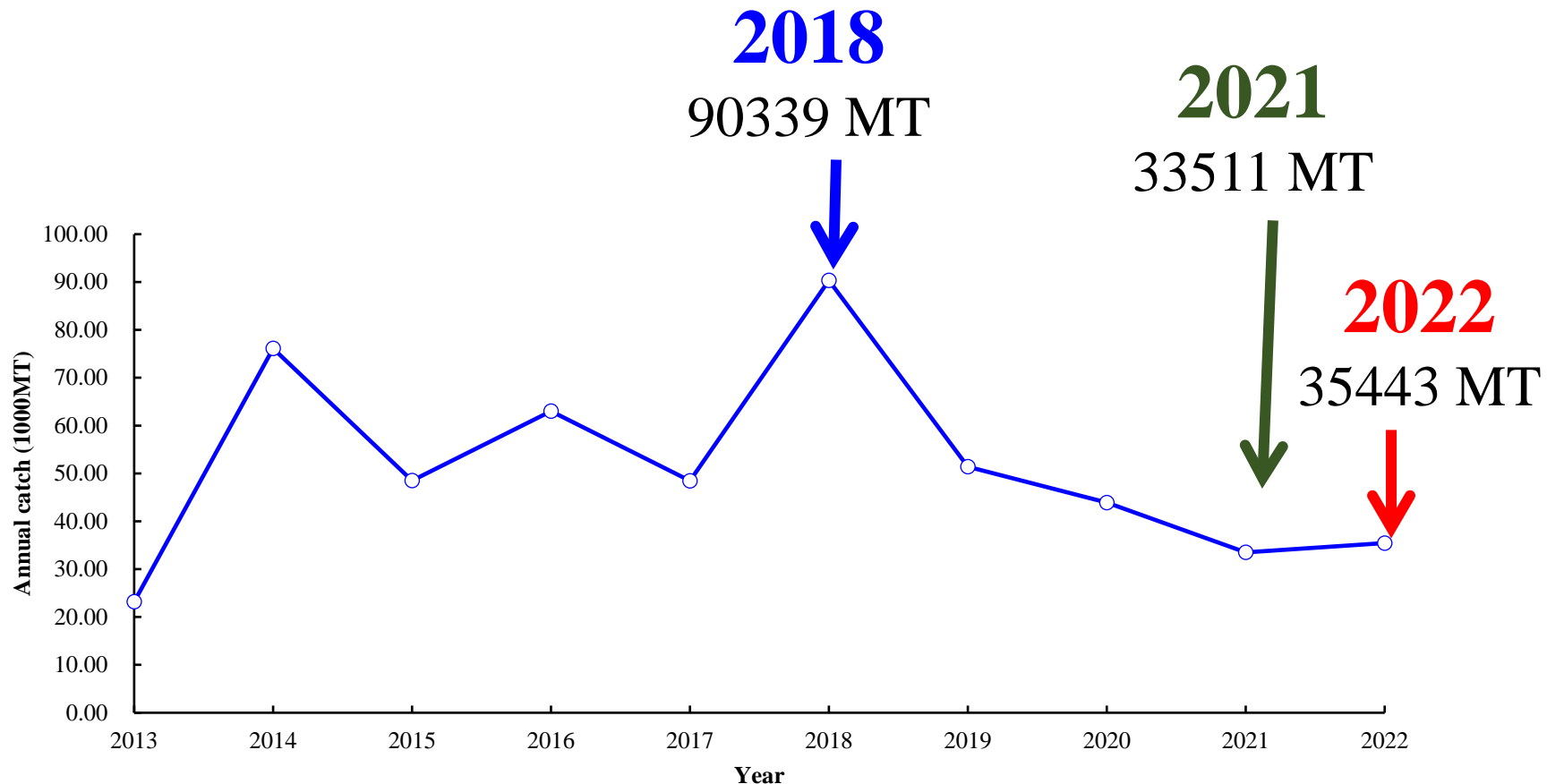

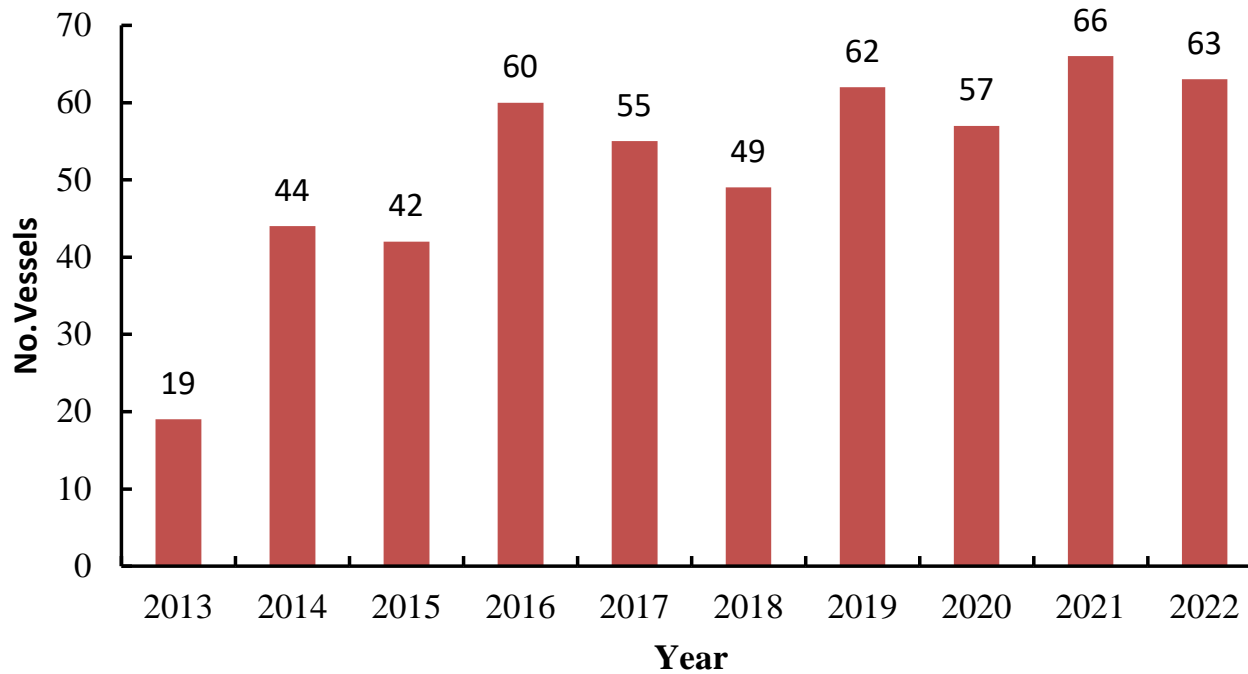

- China's Pacific saury fishery in the Northwest Pacific Ocean began in 2003.
- The main fishing gear of Pacific saury fishery is the stick-held dip net.
- The annual catch continues to decrease since 2018.
- Total catch in 2021 was 33511 MT
- Total catch in 2022 (till 2 Dec.) was 35443 MT

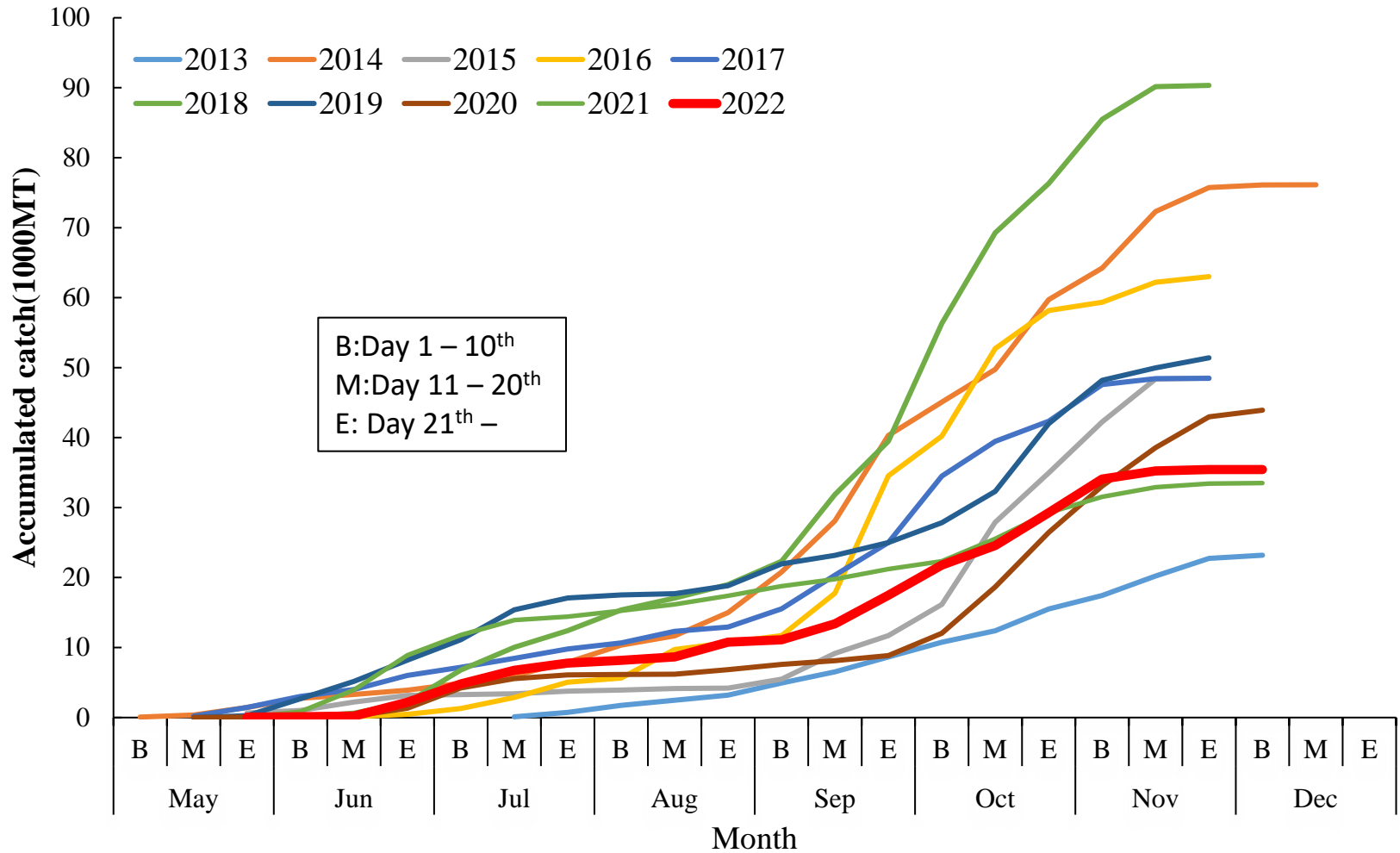
# Number of vessels



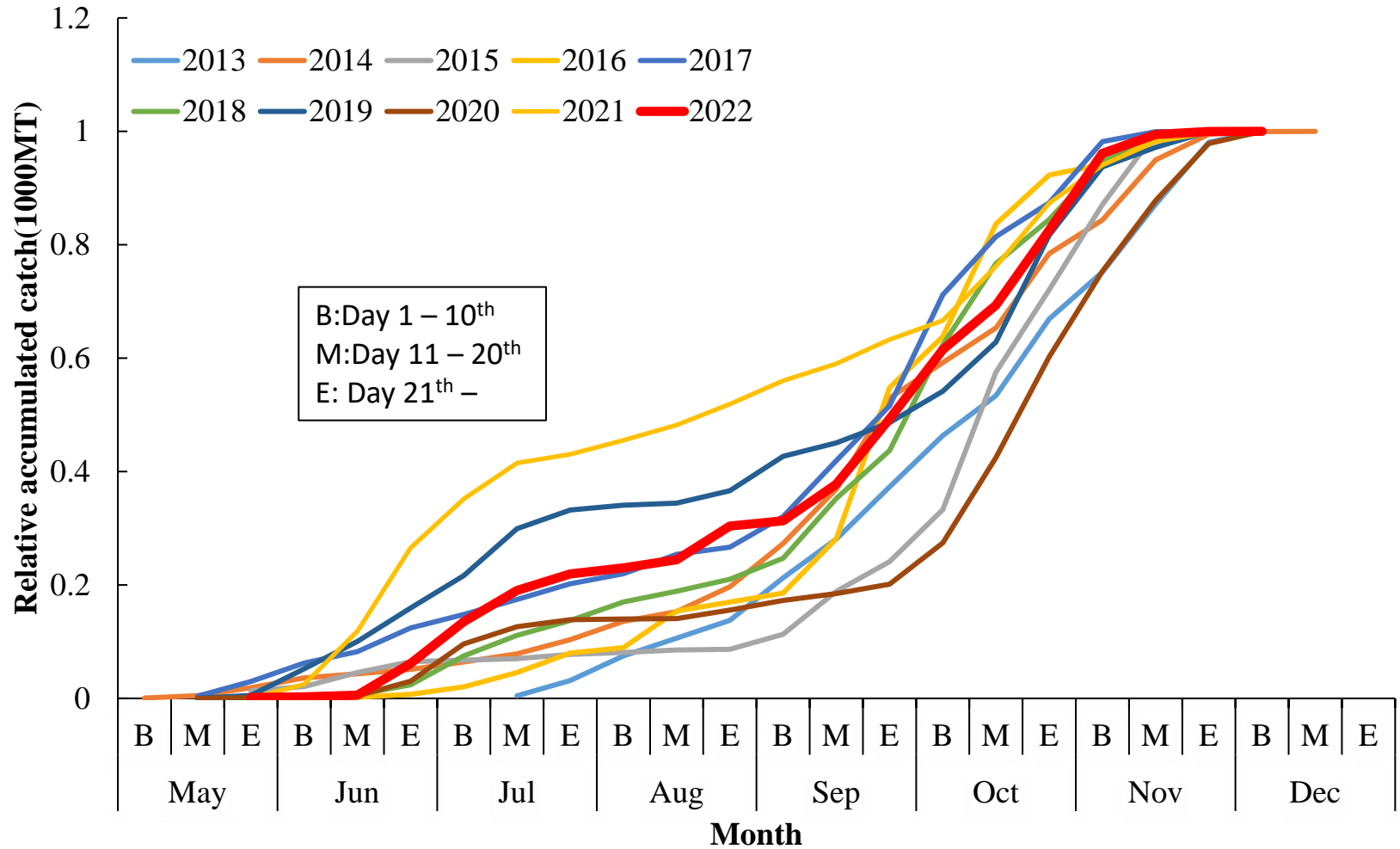
■ **63 fishing vessels are operating**

# Accumulated catch



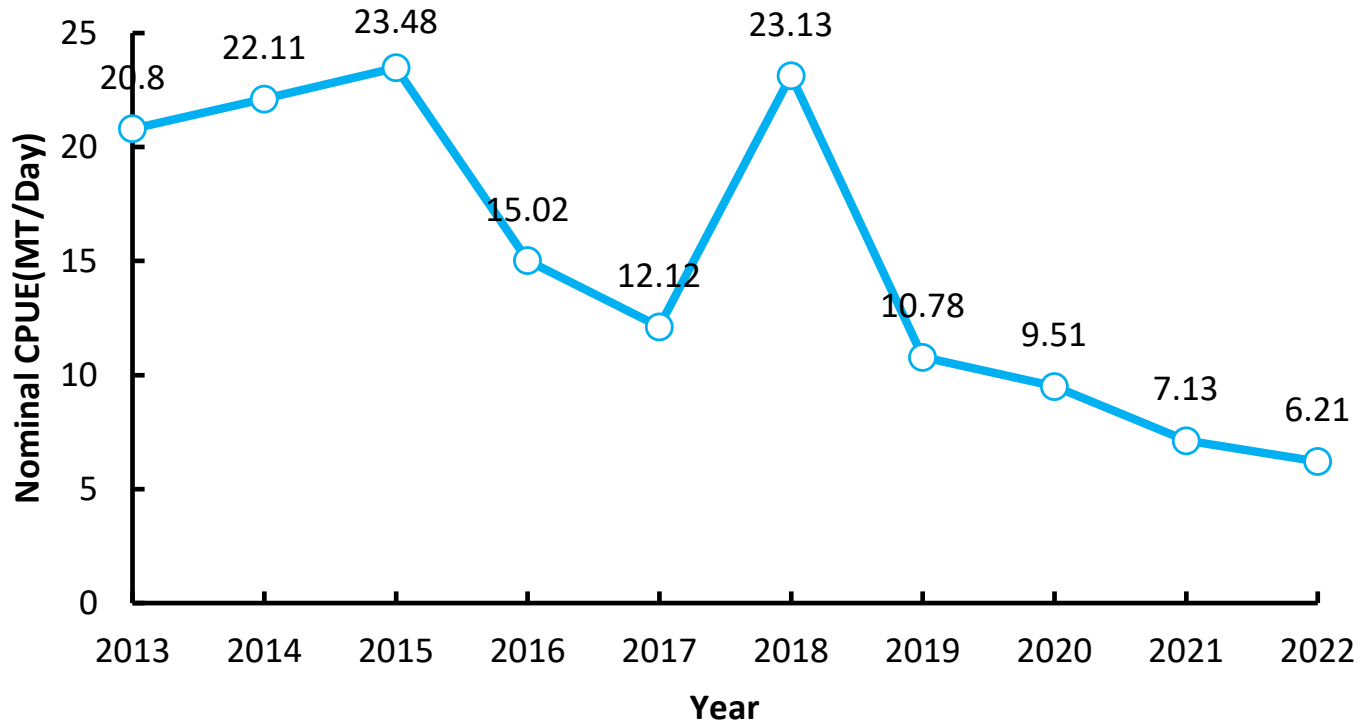
# Relative accumulated catch







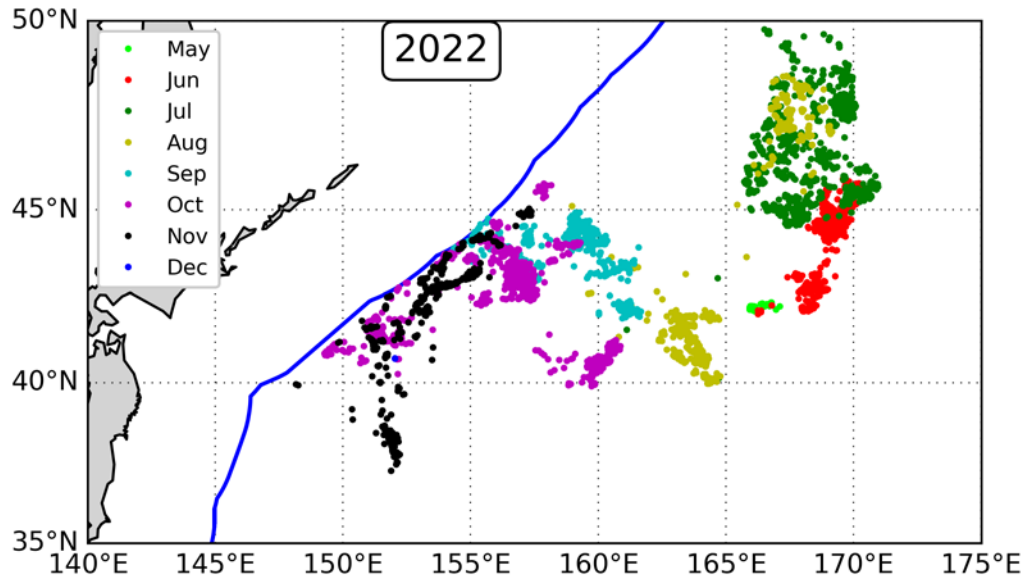
# Nominal CPUE



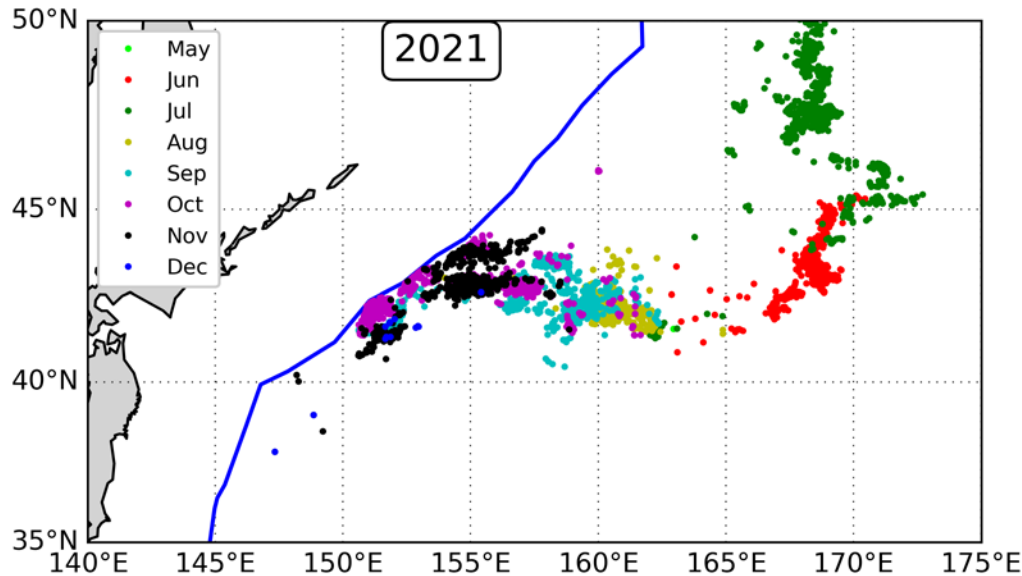
■ Nominal CPUE was 6.21 MT/Vessel/Day and lowest since 2013.
